Dear Dean, dear Fred,

Hereby we send you this short letter as a reaction to your response and concessions on the spending of the Quality funds (kwaliteitsmiddelen). Following your reply, we stress our support for the previously achieved agreement on the three main goals (research-intensive education, *kruisbestuiving* with the city / environment and intensification of study supervision) being executed by teachers with active research. As it was said in your response the FSR FGw does not want the research time to be paid from the Quality Funds. We thank the board for considering and implementing our advice on the following issues:

- 1. Funding research time from a different budget to the Quality Funds.**
- 2. Maintaining the new UD's positions - opened with the Quality Funds - after the funds are spent.**

We have seen the breakdown of the spending, as per request of the OR, and thank the board for the clarification. We appreciate seeing what the ratio of the funding will look like in the upcoming years. In particular, we are excited about the attention towards the intensification of tutoring and the impulse on GSH internships.

As an additional request, the FSR FGw asks the Faculty Board to formulate the given concessions in the usual letter format signed by the dean; we think this is better for archival and referential reasons. Finally, we would like to state that we will closely follow these developments - bearing in mind the goals and explanations found in the memo sent on the 26th of June 2020.
