9. Bring your own device

25 The goal of this agenda point is to introduce the 'bring your own device' initiative and to have a temperature check on this topic. The idea is to use proctoring, on UvA locations. And having the students bring their own laptop, to use during the exam. Not all on location test will be digital. An alternative would be to not allow this, or have the university buy Chromebooks, which can be used during exams. The UCO's unanimous decision was to have the UvA buy the Chromebooks.

30 CSR members find that bringing the own device has more negative effects. Also, it shifts the responsibility of the university to facilitate exams, to the students.

The temperature check for the proposal of Tijmen is 'hot'.

10. Model-OER

The goal of the agenda point is to decide on additions to the model-OER. The proposed change, is regarding the re-sit policy.

Some members think that the existing page, on the website is sufficient to inform the students. Rijk adds that it is possible to add information, on the page of the UvA that promotes student wellbeing. If a CSR member wants to get in touch on this, they can reach out to them.
