1 Currently the consequences of consenting to the language change are unclear to the council. For instance, a
2 change from BA *Cultuurwetenschappen* to BA Global Cultural Studies doesn't only constitute a shift in language,
3 but also a change in curriculum. The council's motivation for disagreeing with the language change should be
4 solid. The council feels that the BA *Cultuurwetenschappen* doesn't require English as the language of instruction,
5 but a new program like Global Cultural Studies could benefit from it. Piraianu adds that it makes sense to him
6 that a programme focused on international cultures is taught in English. However, the rector recently made a
7 bold statement against further internationalization of the university. Therefore, introducing a language change
8 to English seems rather contradictory. There is also the issue of the CROHO label: the programme should be
9 approved and, as of yet, it is unsure whether the programme will stand vast once reaccreditation happens.
10 Hondtong also comments on the need for an international classroom, stating that having a Dutch programme
11 won't prevent students from reaping the benefits of international classrooms in other parts of the faculty.
12 Furthermore, the council also feels uneasy regarding the language change because the change from
13 *Cultuurwetenschappen* to Global Cultural Science will be funded via the Humanities in Context (HiC) budget.
14 This makes the council suspicious of consenting to the language change, considering they are firmly opposed to
15 the current HiC plans.

16 When preparing for the *Overlegvergadering* (OV) the council considers setting up a formal letter before the
17 meeting, especially if they're certain they will be dissenting to the language change. The council would like to
18 ensure that the OC *Cultuurwetenschappen* can still exact their influence and determine what direction their
19 programme should take. Therefore, the concession standard between the council and the board on this topic is
20 fairly high. Piraianu stresses the difference between being opposed to a language change and being opposed to
21 the consequences of a language change. Ballak agrees but warns that they should be careful regarding their next
22 step to prevent the OC from falling into the same trap as last year, where they inadvertently agreed to something
23 without being aware of all the consequences. Kemper suggests announcing to the fDB at the OV that they will
24 receive a dissent letter and Piraianu suggests communicating the pitfalls of a consent to the board and OC.
25 Kemper proposes to dissent to the language change and demand 1) a new advice request for the OC
26 *Cultuurwetenschappen*, 2) a *Toets Nieuwe Opleiding* with the NVAO for the programme, and 3) a consent request
27 for the council regarding the curriculum change. Senchi asks what the council plans on doing when the board
28 agrees to all demands at the OV. Kemper responds that the council will either ask for a postponement of the
29 deadline for the letter or to send a dissent letter which includes the option for the council to reconsider their
30 stance. The majority of the council is in favour of this course of action.

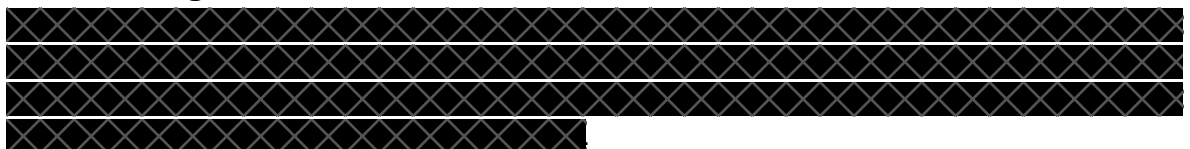


1 OV but will be shared in their letter. All the demands regarding the topic are non-negotiable.

5 request a time-out during the meeting to gauge council opinion. The speakers will consider

It is briefly explained that the previous requirement was 6EC and that currently, without asking for the programmes' consent, the requirement has been changed to 10EC. It has been requested for the council to support the idea of changing the requirement back to its previous 6EC requirement and for the RMA a requirement of between 6 and 10EC. Verveer warns that applying this change to all RMAs might be detrimental. However, she is informed the change would be part of the format for OER B and that eventually the OER B content will be subject to the programme's own wishes.

 - An extensive report from the SoCo in which they elaborate on the application procedure, present their findings and explain why the candidate in question is the most suitable
- The council keeps the names of the candidates and the discussion of the application documents confidential.
- The council can vote on the appointment only after it has received these documents.
- Candidates will only be informed about the status of their application after the council has made a definitive decision.
- If the council rejects an appointment proposal, the SoCo will either:
 - Select a new candidate and write a new report;
 - Write a new report on the same candidate;
 - Step down after which the council votes in a new SoCo
