1 Kemper opens the meeting at 10:24.

3 *Ballak joins the meeting*

3. Mail List & Confirming Agenda

4 The council goes over the to-dos in the mail list. Kemper asks if anyone filled out the Monitor *Medezeggenschap*
5 and asks those who have not to fill it out. There were no big changes in the minor list, except for the addition
6 of the minor Turkish. The meeting with Hanneke Ronnes is Monday [February 7th, 2022]. Hondtong cannot
7 attend anymore due to a change in her schedule; Verveer and Van Eck will attend this meeting. Next Friday
8 [February 11th, 2022] there is a meeting with Wouter ter Haar on the applications. A few ELC members will
9 be joining. Malash and Ouwehand still have to reply to the Our Bodies Our Voice (OBOV) email. Ballak replied
10 to an email, which the DB will discuss more in-depth during their weekly meeting. A student emailed the

32 Kemper tells everyone to read the minutes in preparation for the next OV. She asks if anyone wants to go over
33 the minutes now, this is not needed. Verveer comments that the presentation of Hagen is indeed scheduled.
34 Rather, there seems to be some confusion about the title of the presentation. The council should ask the board
35 to specify what the presentation is about during the OV. Kemper asks those who want to attend to let her or
36 Senchi know so a suitable room can be booked.

38 *Mars temporarily leaves the meeting*

39 5. Updates (MS Teams)

40 Kemper has been busy with the furniture for the new library; there will be a pilot for the next two weeks in
41 the UB with the furniture. Piraianu tells that the chair meeting concerned digitalization, faculty updates about
42 exams, mental health, and the pandemic. Kemper notes that in the meeting she has with Karen Maex next
43 Monday [February 7th, 2022] the process of choosing the new dean has been set on the agenda. If
44 councilmembers have any points that they wish to have discussed with Maex, they should let Kemper know.

1 *Mars rejoins the meeting*

2

3 Mars comments that he wants to have mentioned that the council could not influence the choice of dean but
4 were only able to say something about a previously selected candidate. Hondtong shares that an email
5 regarding OC experiences by student members has been sent out.

5.1. Student Member fDB/CoH/GSH

6 No update.

6. Announcements

7 Hall Allen, Malash, Ouwehand, Van Eck and Senchi are absent. Piraianu will leave the meeting at an earlier
8 moment.

7. Orientation: Dean Election

9 Mars explains the origin of the meeting piece, which is mainly that dean elections should be a democratic
10 process and that it is the council's task to aid the democratization of this process. A number of ways to do this
11 have been outlined in the meeting piece. Ballak asks whether the FSR has not already had the chance to be
12 involved in the process, since Zazie van Dorp was in the BAC. Kemper replies that - technically - they are
13 involved from the beginning, but that they would like to be involved as a whole council. Considering the BAC
14 was confidential, and only one person from the FSR was involved (plus the BAC contains about 20 people), so
15 the influence of the FSR is not really significant. Mars also comments that there is some pressure applied on the
16 FSR when they can write an advice on only one person, which means that they would have no dean if the council
17 does not agree with the candidate presented to them. Svendsen asks who the other people in the BAC are,
18 Kemper responds that the BAC is composed of managers, CvB members, OR member(s), OER member(s), other
19 deans, but she is unsure of who they are exactly.

20 Mars also wishes for candidates to have a sort of policy plan [*'beleidsplan'*] for the faculty, which can be
21 evaluated anonymously, so personality is not taken into account in this decision. Hondtong comments that for
22 the appointment of teachers, there first is a sort of BAC, but then at some point students and other teachers are
23 welcome to follow a test-lecture - perhaps this can be done as well with potential deans.

24 Kemper states that one of the concerns is the law. First, they would probably have to research whether their
25 preferences are legally feasible. Hondtong wonders whether it would be possible for all students to get consent
26 right. Mars comments that this is an end point and is probably not feasible on short notice. Kemper would like
27 a positive incentive for people to vote. Khamseh asks whether they want everyone to have the right to vote.
28 Ballak thinks that they should aim for it but is unsure whether it would be practical. Svendsen comments that a
29 lot of people also do not really know who the dean is or what they do. Khamseh wonders whether there is an
30 in-between step for some people to vote and then others to have the final decision. Verveer states that
31 universities in Belgium already vote for deans, so it can be done. Ballak says that if the FSR as a whole is more
32 involved, that they can also discuss with other students what they would like in a dean. Mars comments that the
33 voting rights for all students has its risks, but it should be kept in the back of our minds, even though it might
34 not be the first step they take. Khamseh says that as a first step he would like to make the process more
35 transparent. Ballak comments that transparency and student engagement are topics they find important, so
36 those things should be considered at all times.

37 Kemper thinks that they should elaborate on this meeting piece by setting up concrete ideas and demands. All
38 agree on the first, third and fourth point. The second point can be used, but how do they need prevent it from
39 becoming a popularity contest. Khamseh thinks that it might be too short-sighted to make it completely



1 anonymous, because some people have a great connection with students that will not be visible in this manner.
2 Mars does not disagree. Kemper says that they can also use this as an example for a procedure.
3 Kemper asks what form their public statement should take. Yet, she stresses that this does not need to be
4 decided now. Ballak thinks they should focus on their faculty first. Mars thinks that Folia is also important.
5 Ballak and Kemper think it is also very important they discuss what things they would like to publish in order
6 to prevent hurting the privacy of the candidate while also stating the council's discontent. Ballak says they
7 should also not jeopardize their involvement in the process by doing this. Kemper wonders whether they can
8 contact the CvB in order to find out if the selection procedure for the dean position is written down. Khamseh
9 wonders what the advantage of an open letter is rather than just discussing this with the relevant people.
10 Kemper says that an open statement can sometimes be more powerful, especially since this particular topic
11 concerns transparency and democratization. Khamseh feels they might be wasting goodwill if they just publish
12 an open letter. Kemper reiterates that they still need to work out the specifics of what they exactly want to do
13 and write. Kemper also says that it is important to keep in mind that the 'official' route will take a longer time
14 and they would have to rush figuring out what they want in order to finish this by the end of the year. Mars says
15 that he wants to write an article on this procedure anyway, but that its content will depend on whether he will
16 write it on a personal title or on the FSR title. Kemper wants a council standpoint on this, so they need to do
17 something with it anyway. Mars asks whether it will be good to have a draft for next week or if they should
18 decide next week whether they would like to have something written. Kemper asks who would like to work on
19 it. Mars says he would like to. However, it remains unclear whether he will have help.

21 *Break*

8. Preparation: *Overlegvergadering (OV)*

22 *Van Dorp and Senchi join the meeting*

23

24 Van Dorp and Senchi are present for the OV preparation. Kemper goes over the OV agenda. Kemper asks
25 Senchi about the Hagen presentation, Senchi is also uncertain because the complete FSR and OR are invited.
26 Kemper goes over the OV action points for Van Dorp's and Senchi's benefit. Kemper asks whether people will
27 be absent at the OV. Everyone that is currently present at the PV will also be present at the OV.
28 Hondtong summarizes the fDB letter concerning 774. Verveer states what Hondtong and she have discussed
29 and what they would like to ask and/or achieve during this agenda point. Senchi asks whether they would like
30 to set the end term and/or whether they would like the fDB to do this. Hondtong thinks the council should do
31 it. Piraianu thinks they should consider the pandemic and whether that makes a one-year extension possible
32 or whether they need more time. Ballak thinks they should set a deadline or else the pilot will drag on for
33 many years. Kemper thinks that continuing a pilot after the evaluation, which will make it a three-year pilot,
34 would not make it a pilot anymore. Kemper offers to demand they stop the pilot. Piraianu thinks that if this
35 next year will help for a better solution, it will be worth it. Ballak agrees with Kemper that it is not a pilot
36 anymore after three years, but also that, when looking at the students' perspective, people are looking forward
37 to an update because it was only supposed to be for one year. Kemper states that it is the fDB's own fault that
38 they did not give good guidelines. Van Dorp comments that they could say that the council agrees with another
39 year if - *and only if* - there are clear guidelines. Piraianu thinks the council should explain their reasoning really
40 well.
41 Svendsen comments that the difference between tutors and study advisors is unclear. She mentions a few
42 goals which are described in the OV prep document. Senchi remarks that study advisors are already
43 overworked, so maybe office hours will not relieve this. Piraianu wishes that more information about the

1 tutoring system is put on Canvas. Khamseh also comments on the idea of a tutor meeting for first year students
2 right before classes start.

3
4 *Piraianu leaves the meeting*

5
6 Khamseh and Ballak will collaborate on the diversity agenda point.

7 The *Stand van Zaken* agenda point about the CoH and GSH council agendas, might be moved to TTO. If
8 councillors have questions about the [agendas](#), they're asked to inform Kemper by Tuesday [February 8th,
9 2022] 15:00 o'clock.

10 Mars is concerned whether he should be the best first speaker. Senchi thinks that maybe he could, because it
11 will be wrong for the OV discussion to be too much about the content of meetings that have already happened.
12 This way, Mars might feel comfortable. Kemper wishes to add that the OER meeting that happened on the 3rd
13 of February [2022] was quite intense. During this OV the summary of the meeting will be discussed. Senchi
14 reiterates that Mars could be a great speaker. Kemper does not think that Hall Allen will be present for the
15 COVID exam point; Kemper will be first speaker and Hondtong second.

16 Van Dorp will need to know definitively who will be present and how much time is needed for each point.
17 Senchi comments that the OV prep document is very empty and that everyone needs to fill out their goals and
18 strategies as soon as possible. [Khamseh](#) wonders if there is any information on the diversity point. Kemper
19 answers that there is no official document, but Ballak will help guide him.

20
21 *Van Dorp and Senchi leave the meeting*

9. Wvttk (any other business)

22 Kemper wants to organize the CoBo. She will send a datumprikket and if the press conference goes well, they
23 will organize it. Khamseh wants to organize more regular fun bonding activities. Ballak asks whether people
24 want to join a transparency workgroup and if there are people who are interested in organizing the
25 *inwerkweekend*; Verveer and Hondtong are interested in organizing the *inwerkweekend*.

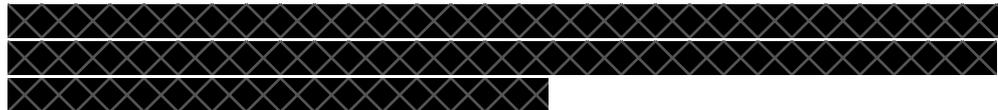

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211112 FSR FGw 2021-2022 their *sollicitatiecommissie* (SoCo) will adhere to the following guidelines for future appointments of council assistants:

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- After the application procedure, the SoCo will choose a candidate that they consider most suitable for the position. Before the council's next PV, the SoCo will present a document to the council which consists of the following parts:
 - A motivation letter from the candidate in question;
 - The CV of the candidate in question;
 - An extensive report from the SoCo in which they elaborate on the application procedure, present their findings and explain why the candidate in question is the most suitable
- The council keeps the names of the candidates and the discussion of the application documents confidential.
- The council can vote on the appointment only after it has received these documents.
- Candidates will only be informed about the status of their application after the council has made a definitive decision.
- If the council rejects an appointment proposal, the SoCo will either:
 - Select a new candidate and write a new report;
 - Write a new report on the same candidate;
 - Step down after which the council votes in a new SoCo
