- 42         Heijnis explains the reason for planning this meeting and thanks everyone for making it so last minute. He  
43         discussed the ethical guideline discussions with Benjamins and Pelikaan. He wants the FSR to decide to pre-  
44         emptively change the plan on how the guidelines will be discussed or not partake in the discussion to not  
45         legitimize the discussion. He asks the council members to read the most recent version of the letter. The  
46         difference between all the meetings is discussed. Van Kasteel says that 50% of students might not be the most  
47         favorable way to put it as there are a lot of good staff members who are then not included in the discussion.  
48         Furthermore, Van Kasteel also says that it is still good to attend the meeting, and he does not agree with Heijnis  
49         that being there is worse than not being there. Tip agrees with Heijnis that being there it's easier to make a thing  
50         out of it than not being there. Heijnis explains that either they change something about the discussion or partake  
51         in the discussion that they think is unfair and help to work towards an outcome that they do not agree with.  
52         Partaking and disagreeing with the outcome. Van Kasteel disagrees, he thinks it's still good to hear what is being  
53         said at the table and bring in critical points in the room, and then simultaneously be critical of the process and  
54         the potential outcome. He does not see how boycotting the discussions is in our favor. Tip says he does not think  
55         50% is unreasonable. Van Kasteel says we should up the percentage and include staff. Tip responds that staff  
56         will already mainly be there. Van Kasteel responded that this is all handpicked staff. Heijnis and Tip discuss how  
57         to phrase it. They discuss the possibility of delegitimizing it from the inside. Benjamins says that it's more  
58         powerful that if the dialogues are unfair then the students will not participate – no student representation in  
59         the dialogues is a bad look. Heijnis does not agree with partaking and then actually having our points heard. Tip  
60         sees the discussion as designed in a certain way to achieve a certain outcome. Stefanova says it shows our  
61         resolve if we do not partake in the meeting. Senchi says that we should find a way to still have eyes and ears  
62         during the meeting but still not partake in the meeting as the FSR. Van Kasteel and Senchi still think that the  
63         information that will be provided at the meeting will be useful. The council also questions if we send someone  
64         else if they will be let into the meeting. Tip does not agree with going to the meeting as it legitimizes the  
65         discussion. Senchi asks what we are winning by not attending the meeting. Tip also says that we should learn  
66         something from how the third-party collaboration discussion went. Senchi concludes that the thing we're  
67         winning from not attending the meeting is standing by our principles and potentially creating outrage. The  
68         council decides to attend the meeting, but not partake in the discussion by form of protest. The council agrees  
69         that this is a middle point of the council members' different standpoints. Tip asks to change a sentence that  
70         includes genocide. He wants it to be changed to a different phrasing. Heijnis and Tip discuss.
