4. Green Commitment

- The council discussed whether to sign the Green Commitment for the remaining months of the term. Although late in the academic year, it was decided to proceed as the document is regularly updated. The council will sign the Green Commitment (11 votes in favor).

5. Longer Hours

- Vote for co-signing the Humanities initiative to open the REC longer during exam week. Vince provided an update: This proposal is being brought to the CvB too. The estimated cost is €18,000 per year, which is considered reasonable. The decision was that the council will co-sign (11 votes in favor)

6. Strategisch Overleg

A kick-off meeting for the strategic year plan was held. Key discussion points included:

- Democracy: There was a debate regarding the use of the word "democracy". The council aims to be more critical and precise regarding its definition.
- Skills & Mission: Livni suggested including technological skills in the mission statement (focus on AI).
- Concerns were raised regarding students entering university with weaker language skills and lower discipline.
- Funding & Budget: Discussions were held on budget cuts and the increasing importance of external funding (e.g., defense funding). The council wants to proactively manage these ethical dilemmas to avoid high-tension polarizations.



- Format: Johannes inquired if a similar format would work for OV/GOV; Livni noted it felt slightly rushed.

7. PR input

- Fabian is meeting with Marleen next week. She has offered space in the newsletter for promotions.
- Suggestions were made to create content (e.g., a Reel or lecture slide) regarding upcoming elections.
- O&F will also provide input for PR.

8. AI roundtable

- On the 2nd of april, 11:00 in the morning
- Attending on behalf of FSR: Noor, Dani, Carla, Tom, and potentially Fabian.

9. Study associations reaching out

- Fabian suggested reposting association events (drinks, visits, etc.) to foster a closer community, provided the feed does not become overwhelmed with reposts.
- Carla suggested organizing a sit-down meeting with representatives from all associations to streamline communication.

10. Date for bonding activity

- Livni will send a When2meet for a social activity. Suggestions are welcome.

11. DB invite

- The Daily Board (DB) will personally invite members to their Monday meetings to check in on progress and offer support.

12. Attendance

- Reminder: Members must notify the board at least one week in advance if they cannot attend GOV or OV. Mandates should be sent to Livni promptly.

13. Office hours

- The council will start a pilot for "Office Hours" (once or twice a week) with an open-door policy to increase accessibility. Johannes will send a When2meet. PR will draft an announcement post.

14. OV recap

- The meeting was more productive than the GOV due to thorough preparation.
- Livni is meeting with Marco today; Nanda has responded positively to the "Top Lunch" idea.
