4. **Charity Run**

The council discussed organizing a cross-faculty Charity Run. The timeline is approximately within two months from now. Will look into sponsorship from the University and external law firms.

5. **Formal Recognition extracurricular activities students**



Vince attended a UvA strategy meeting. Currently, extracurricular work (by both staff and students) lacks formal weight in university promotions or transcripts. The proposal is to ask for formal recognition (e.g., an official letter, transcript annotation, or certificate) for specific student activities. Livni noted the need to differentiate between internships and other activities. Mention was made of the internships and law hubs already providing certificates.

- Anouchka cautioned that this initiative might conflict with the council's stance on reducing student work pressure. Formalizing more extracurriculars may inadvertently heighten "resume culture" and disadvantage students who cannot afford to perform unpaid work due to financial or time constraints.

The council voted on the concept of pursuing formal recognition, with the specific content to be debated during the PV on March 17th. → 11 members voted in favor, 0 against.

6. AI survey

Feedback: Livni suggested ensuring clear language differentiation between the English and Dutch versions + Danial noted that the questions in the survey must be set to 'required'.

7. Updates

a. CSR

- Vince presented a meeting piece on the pilot program of bring your own device (which started at HvA on Jan 12th). Thus far there has been positive feedback, only questions regarding privacy software. The pilot is indefinite and aimed at cost-cutting. Vince will provide a financial analysis after his meeting on the 12th.
- Discussion regarding the "unsolicited advice" for electing e.g. the Rector Magnificus. The council feels the current advice process lacks meaning because decisions are often pre-made/short notice/only verbal. The goal is to get involved earlier in the process via e.g. a blanket MDA.
