1. The Dutch Government must comply with and enforce international law – meeting piece

According to Johannes, the problem in general was the 6-6 balance of the council and whether the piece would pass or if further amendments were needed to secure a majority and if that would change anything.

Critique: Wytze reminded the council that the original plan was for a general statement without mentioning specific countries.

Fabian expressed frustration that members voting against the piece had not provided constructive feedback earlier, leading to a potential waste of time for those drafting it. Danial noted that requests for anonymous feedback had gone unanswered.
