4. GOV recap

a. Integration of Tax Law OC / Assessor Selection Changes:

- The council discussed the practical impacts
- Some members expressed concern that the current setup slightly reduces direct student council mandate, but noted that the FSR retains significant informal influence since the council actively recruits and refers candidates for OC vacancies.
- Proposal: The council agreed that when submitting their final confirmation vote, they would request that the Faculty Board provide clear operational guidelines on how OC representatives are selected for these committees.
- Vote on Agreement (*Instemming*):
 - *In Favor*: 6
 - *Against*: 2
 - *Abstentions / Blanco*: 0
 - *Result*: The council officially grants its *instemming*. Confirmation will be emailed to the Board by the end of the week.



- b. The council expressed collective dissatisfaction with the Board's responses during the GOV, noting that the Dean largely bypassed the core issues surrounding faculty militarization. Danial highlighted the naivety of the responses given current institutional sensitivities, citing a recent VU event concerning structural friction between educators on international law boundaries.
 - i. Carla will text Noor on her view as it was her original meeting piece
- c. Livni reported that Nanda Oudejans had disclosed ongoing internal plans to reform the ALF curriculum, including structural adjustments to remove educational programming in the sixth block. While Nanda stated an intention to seek initial student feedback, this consultation has not yet occurred.
- d. Danial read the finalized introductory text to the International Law Statement to the council. The Faculty Board's overall response to the framing during the GOV was noted as positive.

5. **Charity Run Sponsors**

The council is actively seeking corporate sponsors from law firms. Tom requested assistance from all members to expand outreach. Danial and Carla volunteered to help coordinate contact lists.

Tom noted that collaborative initiatives with the Humanities and Medicine student councils have stalled, and he will post a follow-up strategy on Signal later that day.

6. **Formal Recognition extracurricular activities students – update**

No update was available due to Vincent's absence. Danial expressed frustration regarding the ongoing lack of progress reporting.

- Livni announced intentions to file a formal meeting piece for the next OV proposing a standardized, more descriptive grading rubric across courses to proactively reduce student reassessment inquiries. The draft will be circulated by Friday.
- Carla proposed hosting an official FSR election debate during next year's elections. This will be discussed with the new council during the transfer weekend.
- Danial raised procedural frustrations regarding a delegate's handling of council duties. Carla will contact Vincent to resolve the matter. The executive board will look into establishing a standardized, strict system for mandating votes during absences.
- Anouchka requested all members fill out the "When2Meet" form to finalize council availability. Fabian noted he will attend all June Plenary Meetings (PV) remotely.
