5. **OER amendments → Voting**

PPLE: Many amendment requests were sent. All were initially rejected, but modifications were provided by the faculty.



1. Type of examination → Provision of answers alongside questions. The faculty declined to make a digital environment mandatory for this.
 - We plan on consenting
 - Vote: 12 in favor
2. Right of inspection and Q&A sessions → Inspection moments should be announced at the start of the course. The faculty proposed adding the word "ideally" due to uncertainty regarding capacity. This year serves as a trial; the word may be removed next year.
 - The council plans to consent, despite concerns regarding feasibility.
 - Vote: 12 in favor
 - Note (Johannes): Ensure this is included in the transition file for the next committee.
3. Hardship clause
 - The council has advice rights (not consent). The current definition of "circumstances beyond student control" is unclear and causes stress. The new Dean expressed interest in a conversation about changing this (include this in transition file).
 - Tom will draft the advice by Thursday. Voting will take place online once the draft is ready. Include this in the transition file.
4. Inzagerecht en vragenbijeenkoms → The faculty wants to move the assessment request procedure to the exam regulations. No elaboration was provided. Although they promised to include students, there is no guarantee of formal influence.
 - The council wants to keep this in the OER to retain consent rights.
 - Vote: 12 against consent
 - Studenten met een functiebeperking of chronische ziekte: Requirement for a statement from a Dutch licensed official (BIG-registration). This is problematic for international/Belgian students and Master's students (due to the 1-year duration). A promise for an exception was made during the GOV.
 - Advise including a formal exception rule. Danial will include this in the document. Voting will take place this Thursday.
