### Agenda

#### 1. Opening of the meeting

Ruben opens the meeting at 18:06.  
Janne joins via zoom.

#### 2. Setting of the agenda

The Agenda is set. Point 8 on the budget of the council has been postponed to next week in order to have Janne physically present.

#### 3. Minutes of the previous meeting (September 6<sup>th</sup>)

The minutes have been approved.

#### 4. Review of the action-list

Ruben raises the point of applying for compensation. Tuncay explains that there is one online form for the proper "salary". He offers help to any councilmember who needs it.

He also explains the second form is the Excel sheet, councilmembers can send that to Jeroen van Wolferen. Janne has a meeting with Jeroen soon and she will remind him of processing those forms.

Mark states that the CSR has picked up the USC complaint as was discussed last PV.

Ruben asks Tuncay (PR) about the statement on the ASC initiations. The ASC has stated that the current form will be abolished, what this entails however is very unclear. Tuncay states that the PR committee will make a more general statement on such events as was discussed last week.

Tuncay states that "All Ears Amsterdam" was promoted this morning on the FSR's Instagram.

#### 5. General updates or statements

- a. Central Student Council



Mark states they agreed upon internal topics such as positions.

Mark also states they went to the housing protests as the CSR. Furthermore, they are reaching out to students living in hostels to interview them in order to start working on the problem.

b. Selection of the new Programme Committees

Ruben states the selection procedures are starting today.

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**6. Joint Meeting with the Faculty Board and Workers Council on September 13<sup>th</sup> (Kick-off GOV)**

Ruben states the meeting was very broad and introductory, therefore there is not much to discuss.

**7. Meeting with the Faculty /Board on September 13<sup>th</sup> (OV)**

Ruben states the Faculty Board gave many short updates, he asks the committees to start working on what was discussed.

Vincent has one question: was anything mentioned concerning the changing covid rules? Ruben states that the government will set out the general guidelines, and that UvA will probably just follow those. He adds that UvA will only start implementing new rules when the government has made an official statement.

Alla asks Mark if he can bring up the sustainable travel policy to the CSR. This concerns much more concrete action than the Green Commitment and is most efficiently implemented at the central level. Mark states he will do this.

**8. General discussion on the internal budget of the Council**

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**9. Other points raised during the meeting (WVTTK)**

a. Lectures and Canvas page

Tuncay states he has updated the page and asks for specific input. The general consensus is to keep it as a general point of information.

Sam adds the idea of using it as a platform to introduce the FSR so that students know what to expect. Tuncay states he will implement this.

Tuncay also mentions the fact that the FSR has a WhatsApp number know (the same as the phone number) in order to improve student communication. Chiara adds there is an idea to also make a WhatsApp group where students can discuss FSR related topics, but this is in the works. Amal mentions making a sort of newsletter via WhatsApp for people to subscribe to via a ``verzendlijst``, this idea will be analysed in relation to the aforementioned WhatsApp group.

b. Letter OR to board on the contemplation room

Ruben states the OR sent a letter this morning to the Faculty Board on the topic of the contemplation room. Earlier, the OR told the FSR they would contact the council before contacting the Board. They did not, Ruben will send them an email about this

Vincent asks what the problem is precisely because the letter does more or less agree with the council. Ruben restates the problem being the lack of communication from the OR to the FSR.

Tuncay mentions he would like to revisit the FSR's stance on this topic, this point will be brought to one of the upcoming PVs.

- c. Hollando has an idea for a law quiz

Hollando states he came up with the idea to have a pub quiz like on the topic of law for students to grow closer to not only each other, but also the FSR. The students could play for a gift card and it would be organized about once a block. There is general consensus in favour of this idea. Hollando adds that he would be thinking about also inviting law firms for some networking.

Alla proposes to involve study associations for promotion etc., Hollando will reach out to them in which he will be assisted by Chiara (PR).

Hollando will further explore this idea and keep the council updated.

- d. CoBo of tomorrow

Ruben, Hollando, Django, Mark and perhaps Tuncay will represent the FSR.

- e. The FSR-FdR's CoBo

Chiara states she has been looking into the amount of attendees, she thinks the number of people joining will differ from 38 to 57. Also, the FSR she contacted for a collab did not respond, maybe she will reach out to polisci instead.

Chiara also states that two years ago the budget was 750 euros. She states that last week it was discussed to lower the budget. There is general consensus that lowering the budget is not feasible due to the number of attendees. Janne adds that the CoBo budget will be discussed next week as well during the general budget discussion.

Mark asks if TDP (PPLE) should be invited as well. Ruben states this is up to the PPLE delegates to decide.

Chiara asks if LGBTQ related associations should also be invited. There is general consensus that this is a good idea because they are very new but should be included in these kind of events.

Finally, Chiara states that if anyone thinks an association should be invited which is not on the list yet, they can contact her.
