*We've received a letter ([see attachment 1 for the Dutch version](#)) ([see attachment 2 for the English version](#)) from the dean in which he responds to our advice regarding the TER. Alongside, the renewed drafts for the TER of the Law Bachelors ([attachment 3](#)), Dutch Law Masters ([attachment 4](#)) and English Law Masters ([attachment 5](#)) were sent out. We'll discuss these documents today. Ruben will also elaborate on the feedback we received on our codification proposal ([attachment 6, as a reminder](#)).*

We've received our advices. Word is to Vincent first, then Ruben.

Vincent on the general OER responses, it is what was expected.

Ruben states that the changes that are proposed are very technical, it is not about any content and therefore it is pro forma. Next week the changes will have to be approved.

Ruben states that Nollkaemper responded to the proposal of the FSR to codify the lecture policies. His response was that it is rejected for now. He stated that this is because it is not under the jurisdiction of the FSR to propose any change to these kind of rules at this point in time. Furthermore, the rules wouldn't be very rigid because a lot of courses differ within the different programmes. Ruben states that he does not fully understand this reasoning because the board has stated on multiple occasions that there are in fact rules on this, they are just not codified. The only thing the FSR is asking for is codification. Therefore, Ruben asks if it is okay if he drafts a response to this rejection.. There is general consensus on this plan of action.

Daniel states the JFAS CoBo is on the 19<sup>th</sup> as well.
