1. Opening of the meeting

3. Minutes of the previous meeting (18th of May 2022)

5. Updates from the Delegate to the Central Student Council

The delegate to the Central Student Council can use this agenda point to report on relevant activities at the central level.

Mark states a new Quantum Lab would be built at Science Park costing 70 million. Beforehand, the university believed that they would get funding from outside of the UvA, but it did not work out. The funds will now be taken from other faculties.

Mark also states the CSR has been reached out by LSVB & ASVA about a protest about abolishing BSA at UvA. In The Netherlands, universities have the right to enforce BSA or not. Several years ago there was an evaluation and it was decided that we are content with the current state of the BSA. The CSR has no official stance on the BSA and the general mood was that they are for lowering it, but not necessarily abolishing. Thus, in a vote we did not meet quorum to support the protest as most people abstained. They will send them an e-mail stating that they should contact FSRs about supporting the protests or not. Important information on the topic: FMG has BSA of only 42 ECTS and medicine faculty has no official BSA making each program have discretion on the topic.

Currently the Mijn UvA app will be redesigned to have a schedule of all events happening in the UvA from all associations to make it more relevant. There would be a meeting about it in the second week of June. Anyone from FSRs can attend.

6. Preparing for the OV on the 13th of June

As upcoming Monday the premeeting for the second to last OV will be held, we'll determine the topics we'll be adding to the agenda.

a) PPLE Trust Person

Sam has written a proposal on the establishment of a trust person within PPLE ([attached to last weeks' agenda](#)). We'll vote on bringing it to the upcoming OV. If no quorum is present, voting will be held via email. Consensus on doing the latter has already been established last week.

No quorum present, therefore the vote will indeed be done over email.

b) Tax law professor

Janne states the FSR agreed last week to ask for more information, after which more questions can be asked. She will send an email for this, it will also be discussed at the premeeting this Monday. She will send it out to the council before sending it to the board. The OR will discuss this issue in a small committee, they will update the council accordingly. Janne will also ask them for an update on the diversity report.
