**i. Meet & Greet update**

She also states that the CSR will be at the event and afterwards there will be a bonding activity. Rogier states that he will make a quiz for the event. Tara asks Yoav if there is a budget left for some extra food for the event. Yoav states that it is okay to buy some extra food.

**i. Web lecture surveys**

Tara states that the link to the survey does not work anymore. She and Nina suggest to close the survey and start creating the report on the survey. Nina states that in total 236 students filled in the survey. Nina states that the report will be created based on the data that is from the survey. Emma states that the report should be ready before the next OV. Emma suggests to open up the link again and make the survey available again for students. Katie suggests promoting the survey during lectures. Samir states that this was discussed before but it did not work. Samir states that 236 responses are enough. Tara states that more students could be better for the report on the surveys. Rogier suggests a tactic to promote surveys more effectively and get more responses. He also suggests that an explanation on the WC-krant will be more effective to get teachers to fill in the survey as well. Fabian and Emma will do this in the next WC-krant. Emma suggests to hand out QR-codes to students during lectures. The council does not see a lot in this suggestion.

Samir states that there are WhatsApp groups with all the second-year students. He suggests promoting the survey in here as well. Katie suggests that an explanation with promoting the survey will help as well.

**ii. Core team // feedback for the blueprint before the end of the month**

Tara states that the FSR will give feedback on the blueprint from the core team before the end of the month. Samir states that this blueprint is still a little vague and not concrete enough. Samir also states that giving feedback is a good idea but he is not sure how to give feedback on the vague document. Tara suggests that some members should sit together and take critical points on the document and write feedback. Samir discusses the point of value on giving feedback on the blueprint. Yoav does not agree with this and states that giving feedback is important to have some influence on the onderwijsvernieuwing. Rogier states that it is important to be more actively involved as the FSR during this process and not just giving feedback. Nina agrees on this point. Tara asks the council to read the document critically and take some points for the feedback that will be sent later to the core team.

**i. Green papers**

Tara states that the council should discuss the Green Papers first before the FSR signs it. Tara discusses the paper per article with the council. The council discusses the point on vegan and vegetarian food

options. The members are discussing the definition of “encouraged” in Article 4. Tara states that it is not definitive but the council should and will always decide what the council will have during their events as in non-vegan or vegan food. Emma states that this point should not be a problem because when there will be vegan members, vegan food will be ordered. She states that it should not be a problem to order vegan food. The council agrees to amend sub a and b of Article 4.2.

The council discusses the direct goal of this document on faculty level, especially on the level of faculty of law. The council has some issues with the draw up of this document. Members suggest that a jurist should look into it for the legal binding. The council agrees that the legal effect of this document should be checked.
