Agenda

1. Opening of the meeting

Tara opens the meeting at 15.15.

2. Setting the agenda:

Tara informs the council on the FSR chair meeting. She states that they discussed the kwaliteitsgelden on faculty level. She also states that the FNWI faculty has had issues with stolen laptops and broken lockers. The entrance to the building is open for everyone. Tara also states that another meeting will follow with the rector magnificus.

d. Student assessor letter

Tara states that the council should decide if the council the letter from the FSR-FGw chair. Rogier states that he has some issues with the letter. He states that the job of student assessor is not described well in the letter. He does not like the way the writer of the letter wants to achieve the goal. Nina states that the motivation of the letter is missing. Samir asks what the goal is of this letter. The council cannot find any (clear) goal with this letter. The council votes against this letter (0 in favour, 8 against, 0 neutral).

e. OER meeting / next steps

Tara informs the council on the OER meeting. She states that the council would like to email the Exam Committee on the issue of one decimal marks. She also states that the council has no right to decide definitively on the OER. The council agrees that contacting the Exam Committee is worth trying.

Rogier will discuss the Taaltoets during his OC meeting later this week. Tara states that Rogier should discuss actively as a delegate from the FSR during the OC meeting to represent the view of the council. Nina states that the balance between the courses and the Taaltoets should be more balanced. Rogier will give Nina and Tara an update on the meeting afterwards.

Tara states that some amendments on the PPLE OER will be discussed later during a meeting with Radboud Winkels.

Sebastiaan states that the Tax Law OER will be discussed during his next OC meeting. Tara asks if he can give an update if something new comes up.

f. PR

i. Roeterseiland festival

Tara states that the FSR-FEB would like to organize a Roeterseiland festival. She reads the email from FEB to the council. The FSR-FEB would like to organize a festival with all the faculties on REC. Tara states that it is unclear what the goal of the festival is. Rogier and Sebastiaan state that something similar was organized on REC, called the 'Summer Fest'. Tara states that she will meet tomorrow with the chair of FSR-FEB to discuss the details of this event. The council would like to hear more about this idea. Tara states that in June would be good timing to organize this event.

g. O&F

i. Green office agreement

Tara asks if the council looked into the new Green Office Agreement. She states that the new agreement is not fully binding and a lot of words have been changed. Rogier is in favour of the non-binding clause. He also states that Article 4 on the food and catering is not changed. He states that the value of this agreement is minimum to the council. He states that it will not have any impact on the body of the faculty-student council. Tara states that this document should be discussed with the faculty board as well. They have more power to implement this agreement on faculty level. Samir asks what the function of the Green Office is on UvA-wide level. Tara and Nina state that it is an independent body with an advice right.

Tara and Rogier state that a lot of the points in this document have already been discussed is been implemented in the Working Agreements of the council. Katie states that just signing the document will be a signal on the issue what is discussed in this document. Nina agrees with Katie. Rogier states that this agreement might be more effective for student political parties. Tara also states that the time to discuss this document was also too short. She will also discuss this during the CSR PV. The council votes against the agreement (0 in favour, 8 against, 0 neutral).

ii. Contemplation room

CSR emailed the council on the contemplation room on REC J/K. Katie asks if there is a room for students who want to pray. Nina states that this is the contemplation room. Rogier states that the room should be more welcoming to students.

h. Master student email

Nina informs the council on the complaint letter and the student who sent it. She states that she was asked if it was already discussed with the faculty board. She also states that it is important to discuss this issue with the Master OC. Rogier will discuss this but he is not informed well yet. Tara will update him or she will go to the OC meeting representing the FSR.
