## Agenda

- **Opening of the meeting**

Tara opens the meeting at 15.12.

- **Setting the agenda:**

- a. To-dos

Tara asks the councilmembers to send their agendas to Nina to set the PV for the coming period.

- b. CSR update

Tara states that there was no PV last week. She also states that the IP and diversity nota was discussed.

- c. OV breakdown

Tara states that the attendance was very poor. She hopes that next time there will be more councilmembers available. Rogier asks what the response was from the board for the low attendance. Nina states that the board asked where the members were.

**i. Deaner**

Tara states that everything is arranged for the deaner. She states that she discussed the dinner with Guido and the secretary. Rogier states that it is important that the deaner should be promoted on the social channels of the FSR.

**e. O&O**

**i. Core team**

Rogier gives an update about the meeting he and Nina had last Friday. He states that a lot was changed for the taaltoets but not as much the FSR wished they would like to change. Nina states that the documents were sent too late before this meeting. Rogier also states that the core team acknowledged the proposal of the FSR that the taaltoets should be more legal focused. He states that the PPLE students do not need to take the taaltoets. The explanation will follow later in document added to the proposal. Nina states that second-language speakers (Dutch as a second language) need to take the taaltoets. Emma asks why the proposal on the RWO and getting an 8 of the grade was not accepted. Nina answers that the core team stated that the goals for the RWO course and the taaltoets are too different. Tara states that next week this topic will be discussed thoroughly. Nina states that the core team also discussed the web lectures. She states that in the future some pre-recordings (kennisclips) will be published online for students. This will be for a few courses and is not mandatory for all courses. Rogier states that within three weeks there will be another meeting.

Tara states that there was a meeting about the FSP. She states that the plan will be discussed during another meeting.

**i. PPLE Diversity Board Meeting**

Tara states that she discussed some topics with Radboud Winkels. She states that during the start of the study, the diversity board will help out international students. She also states that there was an idea of having a psychologist inhouse. The council discusses the options that are already available to students. Nina states that the bureaucracy is too much with the psychologists on the UvA and this follows to students having more problems. Tara states that it was a good meeting.

**ii. Contemplation room**

Tara states that she had a meeting with some councilmembers and staff to discuss the contemplation room in REC J/K. She states that the current situation is too bad in the room. Rogier asks if it is possible to study in the room. Tara states that it is not forbidden but it is a room to rest. Tara states that the council needs to discuss this topic because the approval of the council is needed for the changes for the contemplation room. She also states that there will be a temporary contemplation room due to constructions in REC J/K.
