16. Opening

Peterli opens the meeting at 16:00.

17. Mail, agenda, and action list (15 minutes)

The council goes through the mail. Mohammad will RSVP to the ASVA OERTijd borrel invite for 1 to 2 council members).

The council goes through the action list. All trust people will be tasked with realizing the actionpoint pertaining to the team building activity.

18. Announcements (2 minutes)

There are two guests attending the plenary, Neha Thantry and Luxina Guo.

19. Confirmation agenda (2 minutes)

The agenda point on 'Borrel and outreach future plans' is removed per Pandey's request.

The agenda is confirmed.

20. Confirmation minutes (2 minutes)

Lynch comments that it is incorrect that 1/3rd of the UB users are external users. The amendment is added, thereby the minutes of 30-10 are confirmed.

The minutes of 07-11 are confirmed.

21. Updates (15 minutes)

The Chair, Vice Chair, Committees, Student Assessor and CSR delegate share urgent updates.

The chair and vice-chair provide updates. The year plan is currently being drafted. The chairs have decided that the next technical chair will be chosen via a democratic process.

Talboo provides O&F updates. The flyers for the housing campaign are currently being drafted by an external person, given the fact that O&M did not have any capacity. O&F furthermore has discussed internally what priorities they want to set for upcoming block. The social safety meeting was not attended. Planas Buendia will plan in a new date [ACTIONPOINT].

Eng provides O&O updates. They are looking into the University covering for the payment of Dutch Classes for council members. This question will be posed during the upcoming TTO. Furthermore, O&O is in contact with the faculty Diversity Officer to discuss accessibility for students with regards to examinations together with Eng, Peterli and de Campos Neto. Lynch expresses her interest to be involved in this as well. Eng shares that the OER team wants to add an article in the OER on studying with disabilities. Van de Visse has informed the OER team that the FSR will provide comments to this draft article.

Pandey provides O&M updates. Pandey requests all the Committee Chairs to share Committee updates with him for the Instagram update post. Furthermore, O&M has been working on designing council merchandise.

Lynch provides CSR updates. First, the CSR is working on opening more contemplation rooms. Second, the CSR is occupied with the UvA House Rules which covers important and sensitive topics such as freedom of speech and required identification on campus. Third, the CSR has received a consent request on studying with a disability. Peterli has assessed the document and shared the comments with Lynch. Fourth, the CSR is finalizing their advice on the Central Budgetplan. The O&F Committee of the CSR has been in contact with the Central Finance Department on the inadequate communication pertaining the rise in the indexation fee. Lynch will give an informative presentation next plenary to the study spaces situation in the new UB.

22. Discussing – OER Debriefing (15 minutes) (attachments: 0)

The FSR discusses the OER meeting and what to do next.

Van de Visse gives a brief recapitulation of the OER process. Eng says that the likelihood of a third resit being included in the OER is not high. He proposes to include in the OER that if a student has a reason to miss one of the exams due to *overmacht*/force majeure, they can reach out to the Examination Board who will provide the student with an extra exam opportunity. Eng also wants to include the guess correction in the OER.

Peterli asks Eng to expand on the importance of the entire council attending the OV OER. Eng says that it is important for different council members to attentively listen to the different proposals and amendments that are being made at the OV, since it is not realistic or practical for the assigned OV speakers to catch every single thing that is being said during the meeting.

23. Discussing – OV legally binding (10 minutes) (attachments:0)

The FSR discusses a misunderstanding regarding OV and a need for clarification.

Mohammad introduces the agendapoint. She posed multiple questions to the fDB pertaining to the legally binding effect of OV's. Van de Visse will reach out to the legal office of ASVA and Loket Medezeggenschap and inquire on the legally binding nature of OV's [ACTIONPOINT]. Peterli will reach out to the CSR and request for documentation on the legally binding nature of OV's [ACTIONPOINT]. The council discusses the confirmation of the OV minutes. The council agrees that Peterli will be appointed as confirmer of the minutes during OV's.

24. Discussing – CoBo Debriefing (10 minutes) (attachments: 0)

The FSR discusses how the first CoBo went.

Pandey asks the council on their CoBo experience. Talboo suggests to choose a more quiet venue the next time. Groot proposes for council members to wear name tags the next time, as it was hard to distinguish CoBo attendees from regular bar visitors. Peterli wants the transfer document to include an informative introduction on what a CoBo entails and its traditional practices. In general, everyone had a good experience and the council extends their gratitude and compliments to O&M for organizing it.

25. Discussing – Budget (15 minutes) (attachments: 0)

The FSR discusses the usage of the FSR FGw budget.

Eng and Nambiar itemized the FSR's spending last council year. They drafted a budget plan to spend the 13,000 euro's. The council goes through the plan. Eng elaborates on the allocations. Eng clarifies that everything on the list can be immediately bought. The council discusses their interest in Dutch classes and TAQT trainings. The council reads the document thoroughly in preparation of the vote. The council holds a vote on the FSR budget plan.

The Daily Board reminds the council of the FSR House Rules, more specifically the rules pertaining to FSR representation in the media. Pandey elaborates on the rules and clarifies the difference between speaking on personal stances and the council's stance as a body. He reiterates the importance of being mindful which of the two council members represent or appear to be representing when speaking to media outlets. Talboo draws the analogy with council representation during OV's, where council members are expected to represent the council's stance and not their own. Pandey will draft a document on general (conduct)

guidelines pertaining to media representation. Eng clarifies that it is indeed allowed for council members to express their individual stances in the media, as long as it is clarified that those stances are not a representation of the council's stance on a certain matter.

The next VO is planned for the 27th of November. Peterli opens the floor for potential OV agenda points. Lynch suggests bringing the Kitchen in BG5 to the OV again.
