Peterli opens the meeting at 16:15.

19. Mail, agenda, and action list (10 minutes)

Mohammad shares the CoBo invitations. Two council members will attend the FSR FdR CoBo. Six council members will attend the Green Office CoBo. Three to five council members will attend the SES CoBo (European Studies).

Bruseghini shares the date of the CSR's CoBo on the 13th of November from 20:00 onwards.

The council goes through the action list. Lee will send a draft email to Mohammad who will then share the FSR Funds application form with the Humanities associations [ACTIONPOINT].

20. Announcements (2 minutes)

Francesco Bruseghini, former FSR FGw 24-25 council member and current Chair of the CSR, is attending the plenary as a guest today.

Peterli, Lee and Mohammad announce that they will be abroad next week and thus less available.

Eng announces that the council will not be holding a PV next week, including no Committee meetings the upcoming two weeks due to exam week + the Humanities education free week.

De Campos Neto announces that despite the upcoming recess, the trust persons are still available. He furthermore shares that the trust persons will be conducting the evaluations at the beginning of November.

21. Confirmation agenda (2 minutes)

The agenda point on PR of the week is removed and replaced with an agenda point on the Global Peace Summit invite. The agenda is confirmed.

The Chair, Vice Chair, Committees, Student Assessor and CSR delegate share urgent updates.

Talboo provides O&F updates. Given the statement that was published this past week by the fDB on the Faculty's ties with Israeli institutions, the letter that was being drafted by the O&F Committee has become redundant and will no longer be shared with the dean's office.

Pandey provides O&M updates. The council's webpage has been updated by Lee. De Campos Neto asks whether Peterli, Eng, Groot and Mohammad will be available to appear in a council promotion video for the UvA Humanities Instagram page. Pandey shares the volunteer request by the Humanities after Dark (HAD) organization team. O&M will collab with O&O to draft a survey on student wellbeing.

Eng provides O&O updates. They are currently working on the profiling funds together with the CSR. Pandey will look into the profiling funds cutback of study association board members [ACTIONPOINT]. Eng updates on the OER process.

Bruseghini provides CSR updates on behalf of Lynch. The CSR had their first OV of the council year last week. They discussed changes to the social safety regulations of the University, which now includes a central reporting point for social safety related points. The parties furthermore discussed the facilitation of integration by expanding the accessibility and affordability of Dutch classes. Next, the formalization of the lunch breaks was discussed. The official draft of the policy framework for collaborations with third parties is here, and the CSR will have advice rights on it. The CSR is in the process of establishing a Gaza student scholarship. Finally, the CSR is revising the Model OER.

Nambiar will share the new FSR Funds application form with Spotlight as a follow up on their funding request [ACTIONPOINT].

26. Discussing – OER timeline (10 minutes) (attachments: 0)

The FSR discusses the timeline in the process of making the OER throughout the year.

Van de Visse introduces and discusses the timeline. The FSR has received the OER timeline. The FSR has to hand in its proposed amendments by the 3rd of November. Eng explains that attendance during the OV OER on the 10th of November is mandatory. The three areas of importance within the OER are the guess correction, accessibility for disabled students and the third resit moment. The OER division will be drafted by Eng and Van de Visse [ACTIONPOINT]. Lee will look into the OER rules that govern this process and therefore must be complied with by the council [ACTIONPOINT].

Talboo proposes to plan in a meeting with the OR given the overlap in the pursues of both the OR and FSR. The council discusses potential topics they would want to discuss with the OR, which includes the guess correction formula, deadnaming within the University's system, the use of AI at the FGw by both teachers and students, BG5 kitchen plans, and the budget cuts. Talboo will draft the agenda for the meeting [ACTIONPOINT]. Mohammad will plan in the meeting.
